Regional Coordination Committee Highlights

Below are a few highlights from the June 7th meeting of the **Regional Coordination Committee**.

- The Long Island GIS Association (LIGIS) held an in-person meeting at Brookhaven Town Hall for the first time since the start of the COVID epidemic. It was well attended by about 75 people. A future meeting is expected to be held in the Fall.
- The **Westchester County GIS Users Group** recently held an in-person meeting with about 160 attendees on May 18th at SUNY Purchase.
- Westchester County is implementing Esri's Smart Airports application.
- **Westchester County's** representative Ana Hiraldo Gomez and **GISMO's** representative Alan Leidner reported that Con Ed wants to work with their municipalities in their infrastructure mapping efforts.
- The **Western NY GIS User Group** met recently to discuss the NYU Buffalo Blizzard report. The group held a post-COVID lunch an learn session that Geocove sponsored.
- The **GIS/SIG** 2023 Conference was well-attended.
- The **Biden Administration's 30x30 Vision to Conserve Nature** was discussed: https://www.nrdc.org/bio/helen-oshea/biden-administration-lays-out-30x30-vision-conserve-nature. **Westchester County** is looking into participating in 30X30 by reviewing its land use and park areas. Sheri Norton, representing **GIS/SIG**, suggested further discussion on the initiative, including how the NYS GIS Association might participate.
- Molly Jordan is now the point of contact at the **Adirondack Park Agency** since John Barge's retirment.
- **GISMO** representative Alan Leidner reported on the Rat App and progress by NYC in mapping its underground infrastructure and geology.
- Lisa Warnecke of Onondaga County/Syracuse reported that the NY
 Upstate Chapter of the APA will hold a Mini Conference at the Hotel
 Syracuse on 15 September 2023.


