2023 Special Election Results

Heather Ferrero was elected **President-Elect** of the NYS GIS Association in a Special Election held earlier this month.

President-Elect Ferrer is the Deputy Planning Director for Livingston County and has been involved with local land use and GIS in Livingston County for 25 years. An avid mapping enthusiast, she earned Bachelors and Masters of Arts degrees in Geography at SUNY Geneseo and Miami University of Ohio, respectively. Heather has shepherded Livingston County GIS through many transitions: from Atlas for DOS, Atlas for Windows, Arcview, and ArcMap, to online mapping and Enterprise GIS. She has made a goal of her career to put GIS tools into the hands of the public and to make geographic information accessible. She is currently the Secretary for GIS/SIG, an educational user's group that provides a professional GIS forum in the Rochester - Genesee Finger Lakes region.

Additions to the Board of Directors

The changes to the <u>bylaws</u> approved last month necessitated the appointment of two new Directors to the Board. President McCall appointed:

- **Jeff Herter** to the newly created Board of Director term expiring in 2024 and
- **Ana Hiraldo-Gomez** to the newly created Board of Director term expiring in 2025.

They will then be be eligible to serve three consecutive elected terms as Director. The appointments were confirmed by the Board of Directors.
